



## Finance Asia Pacific Scholarship

**Country/SARs and Relevant Financial Market:** Australia (ASX), China (SSE/CSI/SZSE), Hong Kong (HIS,HSCEI), India (NIFTY/SENSEX/NSEI), Indonesia (JKSE/JSX), Japan (NIKKEI), Malaysia (KLIC), New Zealand (NZX), Philippines (PSEI), Singapore (STI/SGX), South Korea (KOSPI/KOSDAQ), Taiwan (TAIEX), Thailand (SET/MAI), Viet Nam (HOSE).

**Application deadline:** Unless otherwise stated, applications will be submitted always before the day in which the course starts and preferably as soon as admission to IE chosen program and intake has been received.

**Objective:** London and New York remain important exchanges in global financial markets, however many exchanges located in the Asia Pacific region are gaining or have gained global recognition as major financial centers. Our intention with this scholarship is to support future financial leaders who will build a career in the Asia Pacific region, during and after their studies at IE Business School. These scholarships are available for the Master in Finance, Master in Advanced Finance and the Global Master in Finance programs; applicants must have admissions to one of these finance master programs at IE Business School; and applicants must possess nationality and practical experience from one the above listed countries. Having professional experience at/with the listed exchanges will increase the competitiveness of the application.

**Description:** Five scholarships will be granted as follows:

- Maximum of five (5) scholarships worth up to 40% of tuition fees for the above mentioned Finance programs.

### Requirements:

1. Having been offered definitive admissions for the program noted above.
2. The scholarship cannot be used in conjunction with any other IE Foundation or IE partner sponsored scholarship.
3. Qualifying GMAT score.

**Documentation has to be submitted through the *Financial Aid Online Scholarship Application*.** Among other documents, these are required:

1. Essay Application Documents:
  - A general essay, where the candidates must explain why you require assistance from IE Financial Aid.
  - What will be the most important financial instruments for companies looking to grow regionally, over the next 5 years? How can financial institutions meet these needs by taking action now?
2. Three last payslips or copy of the last income declaration from the person paying for the program.
3. Additional supporting documents.
