- **Our Service:** Helping admitted degree candidates fund their program of study at IE.
- **Profiles We Serve:** Bachelor, Master and DBA students. We also support Top Management program and Programa Superior students with regards to loan application processing.
- **Options:** Postgraduate scholarships and fellowships covering up to 50% of tuition fees, and loans for postgraduate students of €30,000 or more. We can also help postgraduate students open a local bank account. Some undergraduate scholarships reach 75% of tuition fees.
- **Availability:** From 09h00 to 22h00 CET, Monday to Friday, all year round.
- **Additional Support Information:** Dedicated website, blog and multimedia presentations including video, virtual information sessions and web casts.
- **Percent of Postgraduate Students Receiving Aid:** 40% of incoming postgraduate students and 60% of incoming undergraduate students receive some form of aid.

Funding Your Program Starts with Building a Financial Plan

The first step in making sure you've got the resources necessary to fund your tuition fees and living and/or residential period expenses is to develop a solid financial plan. A financial plan consists of understanding your expenses and then acquiring the resources you need to fund your program and related expenses. Typically a first plan will be reviewed multiple times as necessary and non-necessary expenses are differentiated, and actual resources available become clearer. The key task here is to ensure you minimize unnecessary expenses, seek out the least expensive sources of funding possible, and plan for contingencies should something come up unexpectedly. IE Financial Aid may play a part in your financial plan by providing access to scholarships, fellowships and/or loans, but remember you must contact us before you start your program.

Loans and Bank Accounts

IE works with financial institutions globally to help our students meet their program funding requirements; however our most important partners are local Spanish banks that provide partial loans to both national and international postgraduate degree candidates. The process of applying for a loan from one of IE's partners does typically take longer than applying for a loan from your local bank, so it's important to apply 3 to 4 months before you start your program. IE Financial Aid can open a bank account for you before you arrive in Spain, up to 60 days before your program begins.

Scholarships and Fellowships

To apply for a scholarship or fellowship you must have definitive admissions to an IE master program, and apply using the online application form. Once a complete application form is submitted, cases are presented to the Scholarship Committee at IE which typically processes cases in 3-4 weeks so as to support our rolling admissions process. Scholarships can range in value, so it's important to review the Financial Aid web site in detail before applying.
